Besides maintaining the property the Board of Trustees is responsible for ensuring the Articles of Incorporation of the congregation are kept up-to-date,

review property, liability, and crime insurance coverage on church-owned property, buildings, and equipment. The team also reviews personnel insurance for protection against risk, and consults with the Pastor-Parish team about other personnel insurance.
